

PSHE Lesson Plan: The Hidden Dangers of Gambling

Objective: Students will understand the risks and consequences of gambling addiction, recognize the signs of gambling problems, and know where to seek help.

Materials Needed:

- Video script
- Computer and projector
- Whiteboard and markers
- Student handouts
- Access to the internet (optional, for further research)

Lesson Duration: 60 minutes

Introduction (10 minutes)

1. Welcome and Objective Overview:

- Greet students and explain the lesson's objective.
- o Briefly discuss what gambling is and why it can be addictive.

2. Pre-Discussion:

Activity: Group Discussion and Role-Play (15 minutes)

1. Group Division:

Divide students into small groups.

2. Discussion Questions:

- How can we support a friend or family member who is showing signs of gambling addiction?
- What are some healthy ways to cope with stress and problems instead of gambling?

3. Role-Play Scenarios:

- Each group creates a short role-play demonstrating how they would help a friend struggling with gambling addiction.
- o Groups perform their role-plays for the class.

Conclusion and Handout Distribution (10 minutes)

1. Summary:

- Recap the key lessons learned about the dangers of gambling addiction.
- Highlight the importance of seeking help and supporting each other.

2. Distribute Handouts:

 Provide each student with the handout summarizing the lesson and additional resources.

o Open the floor for any final questions or comments from the students.

4. Resources:
